During this month, which begins with the celebration of All the Saints, the Church asks us also to remember the faithful departed – the Holy Souls now in purgatory.

We can do this by praying for them, and offering Mass for them. You can add a list of those you would like to be prayed for to our 'November Dead List', using the envelopes provided, and Masses for the Holy Souls will be offered throughout November.

Today, Sunday 6th November, there will be a brief blessing of the cemetery after the 11.00 Mass (weather permitting), and next Sunday (Remembrance Sunday) the 11.00 Mass will as usual be offered for the dead of the two World Wars (Fr Richard will also be representing the parish at the Remembrance Service in Sheen).

Lastly, on Tuesday 8th November our parish will be hosting the annual Deanery Requiem, for all the deceased clergy of the deanery. Mass that day will be at 12.00 noon, and all are welcome, and encouraged, to attend. The Mass will be concelebrated by priests of the Deanery.
