Children who are not at St Mary Magdalen's Primary School, but who are in Year 3 and above, and who already attend Mass in this parish, may also register for First Communion classes, which will run on Sunday mornings after the 9.30 Mass. Again, all registration forms must be returned to the Parish House by Sunday 27th November.
