### **Appeal for famine-torn South Sudan**

Bishop William Kenney, auxiliary Bishop of Birmingham, has called on the world to wake-up to the man made humanitarian disaster playing out in famine-torn South Sudan - a country he visited in 2012. Speaking in response to a Pastoral Letter issued by the Catholic Bishops of South Sudan, Bishop Kenney said: "Having visited the country over the past few years, I commend the pastoral message from my brother Bishops in the South Sudan. The people of that country are suffering a brutal civil war, resulting in widespread violence, economic breakdown and famine. The world must wake up to this man-made humanitarian disaster. The violence must stop and the international community must intervene. We, the Catholic Bishops of South Sudan call on the international community for immediate and unconditional concrete intervention and action before thousands of innocent lives are carried away and before it is too late. We urge the Caritas Internationalis and International community to take all necessary steps for immediate action.
