Collection details: Our sacrificial giving is part of our participation at Mass and a sharing of the blessings God gives us. Our thanks also go to those who donate by Banker's Order direct into the parish account which provides, on average, £400 to total £945. In addition, we raised £237 towards the cost of decorating the church at Christmas through our second collection.
