He was a faithful servant of the Church and especially of the two dioceses of which he was the chief shepherd. Please do pray for him and his family. I have asked all parishes in the diocese to arrange for a Mass to be celebrated for the repose of his soul as soon as is practical and that Archbishop Michael be remembered in the Prayers of the Faithful at Masses As soon as funeral arrangements this weekend. become available I will ensure that this is circulated.
