

Feast of the Epiphany

As we come toward the end of Christmas it is worth reflecting on Pope Francis' Christmas message (Ubi et Orbi) and learning how we might approach the New Year:

By his incarnation, the Son of God tells us that salvation comes through love, acceptance, respect for this poor humanity of ours, which we all share in a great variety of races, languages, and cultures.
