New Lectionary from Advent 2024: The Lectionary is the book which contains the Scripture readings used at Mass which is being updated as part of the continuing process of revising the liturgical transations which began in 2011. These changes have been made to the make the translation from the original languages more faithful to the original, provide a text that is more proclaimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive. This means that the Parish will need to purchase a new set of books which will cost £395. If you feel that you can make a full donation for this, or perhaps, a contribution, towards the cost, please contact the Parish Office with "Lectionary" in the title, with your proposal.
