

School Applications for the next academic year

Naturally, the transfer and application process can be an anxious and difficult time for both parents and children. Even though I have just arrived in the Parish, please be assured that requests for references will be dealt with as soon as they have been received from the parents and/or schools concerned. Please note that all parents applying for a school reference are requested to see Fr Adrian to obtain and complete Parish request for each child seeking a place. This is a Parish form, not the school one and is called the "Initial Application for a School Reference from the Parish Priest." This yellow form can be collected from Fr Adrian after every Sunday Mass. If you have received a Priest's Reference from the school(s) you have applied to, please follow the instructions printed on that form as each school has a different process.

- · PLEASE NOTE: if the school has requested that a parent has to return the reference then the form must be posted into the Presbytery after any Sunday Mass, so that the reference can be collected from Fr Adrian after any Mass the following weekend.
- if the school has requested that Fr Adrian has to return the form then the form must be accompanied by an envelope addressed to the school with a stamp attached sufficient for the postage NB a separate envelope is required for each school.

Once you have returned the Parish Form, Fr Adrian may contact you to book an appointment to discuss the transfer process at one of several 'Open Evenings', the dates and times of which will be announced in future newsletters, thank you for your understanding.

Thank you to the parish members who submitted their CVs for the role of Office Manager. Once Fr Adrian has a new job description he will advertise this again and will be in contact with all who submitted their CV.
