We would like to welcome to Fr Piyal Jayathilaka, from Sri Lanka, who is assisting at St Mary Magdalen throughout the whole of July and will be cover for Fr Adrian when he's away from the 16th to 20th inclusive.



Today we pray especially for all those who live and work at sea. Seafarers and fishers play a vital role in all our lives, but they often work in difficult, STELLA MARIS hazardous conditions. Through its extensive

network of port chaplains and ship visitors, Stella Maris/the Apostleship of the Sea, offers pastoral and practical assistance to seafarers who work far from home, separated from their families, and sometimes in harsh working conditions. Stella Maris port chaplains and ship visitors offer practical and spiritual and emotional support including arranging for Mass and prayer services on board ships and being a friend to them. Nearly 95% of what we consume in Britain arrives by ship crewed by seafarers and we are dependent upon them to bring us what we need. Many of whom come from Catholic countries such as the Philippines,

Changes to the Bible Readings at Mass - New Lectionary Translation from Advent 2024The Lectionary used at Mass contains Bible readings set out over a two or three-year cycle and, as part of the continuing process of updating the liturgy which began in 2011, the Lectionary is changing. These changes have been made to the make the translation from the original languages more faithful to the original and, where appropriate, more inclusive. This means that the Parish needs to purchase a new set of the three Lectionaries used at Mass at a cost of £395 for the three-volume set. Some Parish Families asked Fr Adrian if they could contribute towards the cost, and he would like to have a Dedication Page for the front of each volume so that families could either dedicate a single volume to a loved one's memory or have a chosen name included in a list of donors.
