New Lectionary from Advent 2024: The Lectionary is the book which contains the Scripture readings used at Mass which is being updated as part of the continuing process of revising the liturgical translations which began in 2011. These changes have been made to the make the translation from the original languages more faithful to the original, provide a text that is more proclaimable and, where appropriate, more inclusive. This means that the Parish will need to purchase a new set of the Lectionaries used at Mass at a cost of £395 for a three-volume set.

Fr Adrian has spoken to some Parish Families who would like to make a contribution towards the cost and he has arranged for white envelopes marked "LECTIONARY" to be available, from the table at the back of the church.
