The EU Settlement Scheme

Bishop Paul McAleenan has issued a statement on behalf of the Bishops of England and Wales about the government's forthcoming Settlement Scheme for EU citizens living in the UK. Any EU citizen wishing to remain in the UK after Brexit (with the exception of Irish citizens) will have to apply through the scheme, which is expected to launch in March 2019.

In the statement, the Bishops express 'solidarity with all EU citizens who have made their home here'. As the majority are Catholic, the Bishops said that 'this is a special pastoral concern' for them. Speaking of these EU citizens, they said: 'They are an integral and valued part of our parishes, schools and communities.'

With regard to the Settlement Scheme, they said that, while this is an important step, they understand that 'it may feel unjust and divisive that they are now required to apply for permission to stay'. They expressed concern that 'some people, particularly those who are already vulnerable, may face difficulties in practically accessing the scheme, leaving their immigration status at risk'.

They have urged Catholic parishes, schools and organisations to make people aware of the Settlement Scheme and 'to be aware of vulnerable people who may face barriers to applying or not realise they need to apply', making use of the various information resources available.
